Franklin SEPAC invites you to learn more about Collaborative Problem Solving with Dr. Ross Greene

Dr. Ross Greene is Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry at Harvard Medical School and the originator of the Collaborative Problem Solving (CPS) approach. He is the author of the highly acclaimed books **The Explosive Child** and **Lost at School**. He lectures all over the world.



Dr. Ross Greene founded **Lives in the Balance** to advocate on behalf of kids with social, emotional, and behavioural challenges and their parents, teachers, and other caregivers, and to provide free, web-based resources to help people learn about and implement the CPS model. Dr. Greene will provide an in-depth review of his model for supporting children who demonstrate challenging behaviors, specifically focusing on working with children and families, how parents can implement CPS at home.

The workshop will be presented at 7:00pm in the Horace Mann Middle School Auditorium, 355 East Central Street. The workshop is free and open to the public.
